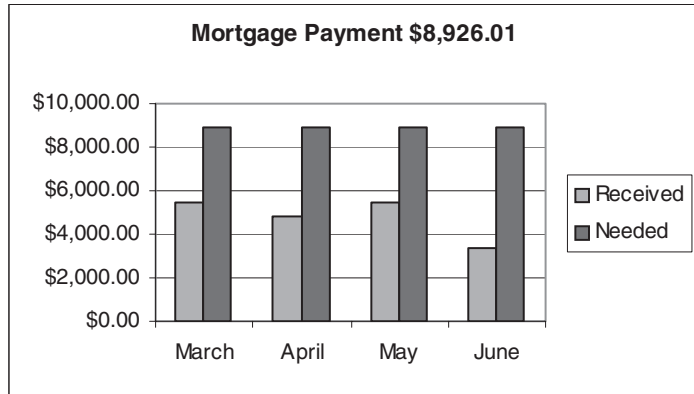

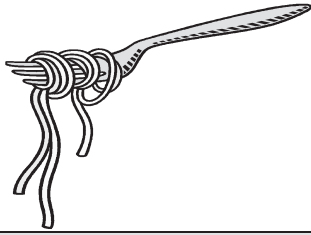

From the Pastor's Desk

Pastor's Notes

Now that we have started into Summer, my thoughts have turned to the Fall. I will definitely take some time to enjoy the Summer, but while I am in the office I will be doing some planning. Many of you will probably be doing the same.

Some families will be scheduling new student orientations for their children who are heading off to college. One thing parents ask themselves is "where can my son or daughter go to be involved in Church while in college?" There are a couple ways to find out this information.

At Catholic colleges one can simply contact the chaplain's office for information. There will usually be a regular schedule of Masses, as well as some organized groups that may be of interest. They may have policies with regard to contacting new students to welcome them, so you might want to check whether you need to get your child's name on a list for that.

At other colleges you may have to do a little more digging to find similar information. There may be a chaplain's office, or it may be called Spiritual Care, or Pastoral Services, or something similar. It may be an office of the college, or it may be a student organization like a Newman Student Club. If all that fails, you may have to go to www.Masstimes.org and plug in the local zip code for local Churches.

After finding these contacts, perhaps together with your child, there is not much more you can do. As youth grow into adulthood they take on more responsibilities. When away from home they will be responsible for their participation in the life of the Church. Parents can encourage, support, and remind, but cannot do this for their children. They can, however, do two very important things. Parents can continue to be a good example of faith for their children, and they can pray for them. Both of these are very powerful actions.

As families plan ahead for this, we at St. Theresa parish also will need to plan to reach out to the Catholic students at New England College to make it clear that we want them to live out their faith here with us while they are living among us. If you have ideas as to how we can do this, please let me know.

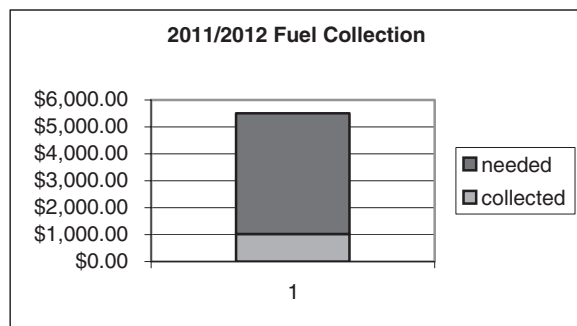
